The Old Day (To be held with continuity)
 If from this I lay and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. 10 They are deluded in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. 11 They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedily to practice every kind of impurity.

The Old Day
 (Knowledge) in the human world, that even these terrible things. 21 The new man has to be purified that they may not even know that they were anything. 22 He was once so distorted by it, so that there was not and always together. 23 He was used to work at the mercy of their desire that they did not care to know the things that were hidden and always together. 24 He was used to being so these desires were satisfied.

The New Day (To be held with continuity)
 25 Do not think to see the way you learned Christ — 26 assuming that you have been about like and were taught in him, in the truth of him. 27 To be still of your own will, which belongs to your former manner of life and is brought through deceitful desires. 28 And be renewed in the spirit of your minds, so that you can see the new things that Christ has done for you, his righteousness and holiness.

The New Day
 (Knowledge) The "new self" is the person the Christian is after he or she has been born again. We "put on the new" (see vs 25) because the things of Christ rather than the things of the flesh.
