Ephesians 4
1 Be imitators of God, as Jesus Christ, who is the image of the invisible God, who has made himself known in the flesh and dwelt among us, and who, though he existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be grasped. 2 He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. 3 He made himself obedient to the point of death, even the death of a cross. 4 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above all names, so that in the name of Jesus Christ every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of the Father and of the Spirit forever and ever. Amen.
