Genesis 3

1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden?'"

2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may not eat fruit from the tree in the garden,

8.

3 But God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'

4 'You will not certainly die (lie)', the serpent said to the woman. 5 'For God has said that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.' (check ver)

9.

6 When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. (truth)

7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked, so they covered (lie) themselves and made coverings for themselves. (Shame)

8 And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, but the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

11.

9 But the Lord God called to the man and said to him, "Where are you?"

12 And he said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself."

12.

13 He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I told the man not to eat?'"

14 The woman said, "The woman whom you gave to be with me (check ver) ate from the fruit of the tree. (check the woman) I ate it."

15 Then the Lord God said to the woman, "You are guilty of sin. The serpent deceived you, (check the serpent) And I see"

16 When the Lord God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of us in knowing good and evil," He hid him away from Adam and Eve forever.

17 Therefore the Lord God sent him out from the garden of Eden (lie) to work the ground from which he was taken. (check ver) 18 Adam said, "The serpent deceived me, (check ver) and I ate."
