

The **WORD** to the Jewish mind
So when John was searching for a way in which he could
conceive Christianity he looked in his own Bible and in the
record of his own people the idea of the world, the
ordinary word which in itself was merely a sound, but a
dynamic thing, the word of God by which God created the
world, the word which expressed the very idea of the
action of God, the mission of the Wordless Language which
was the eternal creative and illuminating power of God.
