Old Day vs. New Day

The Old Day (to be held with continuity)

If from this I lay and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. 18 They are deluded in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. 19 They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedily to practice every kind of impurity.

The Old Day

Knowledge: In the human world, Paul saw three terrible things. 20 The one was how to be grateful that they were not even aware that they were sinning. 21 He saw men so deluded by the lies that demons were told and deceiving themselves. 22 He saw men so much at the mercy of their desires that they did not care where the they traveled and where someone they depended on being so these desires were satisfied. *William Barclay*

The New Day (to be held with continuity)

20 Do not think to say to me you have not Christ — 21 knowing that you have been about like and were taught to live, in the truth to know. 22 Do not say that you are not of God, which belongs to your former manner of life and is changed through deceitful hearts. 23 And do not measure in the depth of your minds, all and to put on the man: the Christ! after the likeness of God in his righteousness and holiness.

The New Day

Question: The "new self" is the person the Christian is after let 20 in the evidence now left. We "put on the new" (not as we) receive the living of Christ rather than the absence of the flesh. What has created the new self (the Christian) at regeneration, after the image of "the Old Day" (to be held with continuity)? What "oldness" do you discern?

Checking our **assumptions**

20 Do not think to say to me you have not Christ — 21 knowing that you have been about like and were taught to live, in the truth to know.

Assumption 18: We are connected to heaven

The demands of life in a **golfed community vs 25-27**
