A Clear Picture of the Owner/Steward Relationship

Definition of Terms

Owner, noun: One who legitimately has, holds or possesses.

Definition of Terms

Steward, *noun*: a person who manages another's property or financial affairs.

-Key Proposition (KP) of this series:

God owns everything and I'm his steward.

-Typical Objections to the KP-

Objection: "I love money, I need money-my PRECIOUS!"

Biblical Response: "No one can serve 2 Masters." Luke 16:13

Objection: "Can't be a steward until I have enough...My PRECIOUS!"

Biblical Response: As Jesus looked up, he saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins. "Truly I tell you," he said, "this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on." *Luke 21:1-4*

Objection: Say what? What I hold is the result of my blood, sweat, tears, education, street smarts, negotiating skill, take no prisoners attitude, plaid jacket...My PRECIOUS!"

Biblical Response: "Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell me, if you understand." *Job 38:4*

Biblical Response II: "But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant." *Deuteronomy 8:18*
