the salvation of our God.**



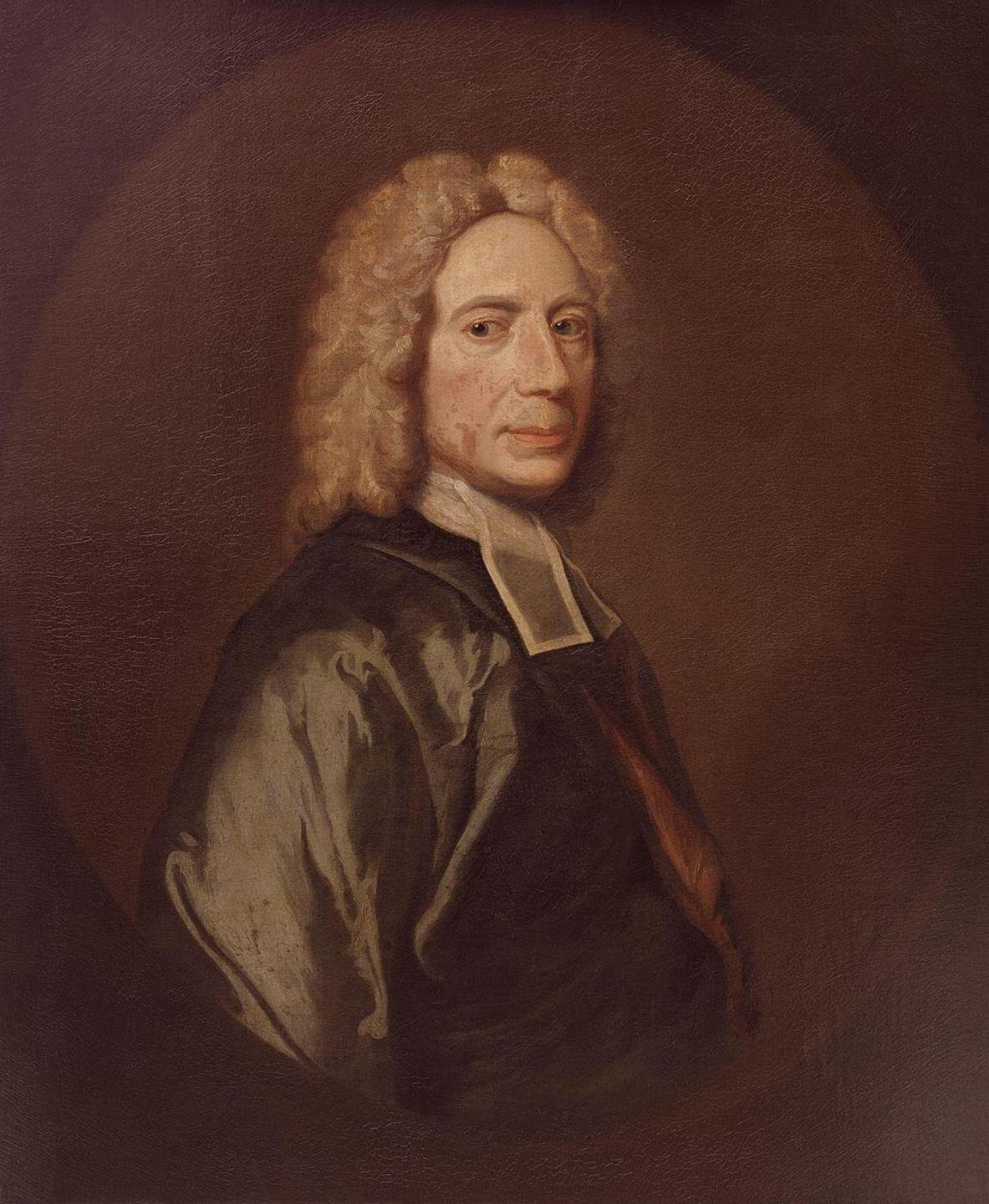
**4 Make a joyful noise to the Lord,
